

Lake Linganore Association Pool Rules and Regulations

(Revised January 1999)

General

1. No member allowed admission until dues, fees, and fines are paid in full or current on payment plan.
2. Lost or stolen membership cards replaced at a cost of \$5 per card.
3. Members, associates, and guests use recreational facilities (including pool and tennis courts) and property at their own risk. LLA is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to personal property or for articles left in automobiles or on pool grounds.
4. Members and guests are responsible for own willful or malicious damage to facility.
5. Members and guests must show passes to use facility.
6. Bicycles may not park directly in front of pool entrance.
7. No bicycles allowed on tennis courts.
8. Gas-powered model airplanes, racing cars, go-carts, mini-bikes, skateboards, roller skates or rollerblades also prohibited from tennis and basketball courts, swimming area, and parking lots.
9. Pool management has the authority to suspend privileges.
10. Pets prohibited.
11. Rough play, running, offensive language or other objectionable personal conduct will not be permitted in the pool area.
12. Any person who climbs over a pool fence will be dealt with as a trespasser.
13. Members may use pool pay phone only.
14. Complaints should be made to pool manager of the pool management company (Century Pool Management). Pool management is responsible to LLA general manager.
15. Admission to pool will be denied to intoxicated persons. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited from association property, except for official LLA social functions approved by the LLA board.
16. Pool and tennis activities may occasionally be restricted from general use in order to permit special events, as authorized by the board of directors.
17. Members of age and eligible to use pool facility without parent accompaniment (see pool regulation #23) must sign-in upon entering the pool.

LLA Pool Regulations

1. Pool manager may close pool during lightning or hard rain. Pool must be cleared minimum of one-half hour.
2. Lessons and team practices are scheduled to avoid conflict with general usage.
3. One lane may be made available for swimming laps at the guard's discretion. Adult swimmers have priority in lap lane at all times.
4. No street shoes worn on the deck.
5. Bathing suits must be worn— no cut-offs allowed.
6. No running, pushing, pulling or throwing others into the pool.
7. No playing on ladders, hand rails or stairs.
8. No cartwheels or back dives from the side of the pool. Front diving will only be permitted in the deep end.
9. Instructions of lifeguards and pool manager must be obeyed.
10. No pool usage unless facility is officially open with guards on duty.
11. Minors are not permitted to smoke or drink in the pool/cabana areas or inside/outside of the fence, as required by Maryland law.
12. Litter must be placed in proper receptacles.
13. Only children six-years old or younger may use baby pool, and must be **supervised at all times** by an adult.
14. Glass or breakable objects not permitted in pool area.
15. Chewing gum is prohibited.
16. Pool manager will exercise discretion in allowing articles such as balls, masks, and pool toys in the pool. Inner tubes with vests, life jackets, and water wings are permitted if child is closely supervised at all times by an adult (one child per adult). No rafts or inner tubes.
17. Children not potty-trained **MUST** wear rubber pants over diapers while in pool area.
18. Spouting water, spitting, and nose blowing are not permitted.
19. Children 16-years and under will leave the pool during the last 15 minutes of the hour to allow for adult swim time.
20. Children under two-years of age not permitted in the pool without supervision.
21. Radios, televisions or tape recorders must be used with headphones.
22. **Diving Regulations:**
 - a. Diving well is closed for swimming unless lifeguards agree to supervise games.
 - b. Only one person on the diving board at a time.
 - c. A diver may proceed only after the previous person has cleared the area.
 - d. Front diving only off the board. No inward, cartwheel, seat drop or back flips.

23. Pool Admission Policy:

- a. Children 10 years of age or older who can demonstrate acceptable social behavior and swimming ability by passing the swimming test to the satisfaction of the manager, may be at the pool alone. Swimming test consists of 25-yard lap (from shallow end to deep end) without stopping and treading water for one minute.
- b. Children under 10 must be accompanied by a responsible person 16 years or older.
- c. Anyone under 18 years can supervise only one child at a time.
- d. Admission may be denied to those with skin infection, inflamed eyes, nasal/ear discharge, communicable disease, excessive sunburn or open sores.
- e. Violation of the rules constitutes dismissal from pool. Duration of dismissal determined by lifeguards and/or pool manager.
- f. Members may be denied admittance when pool reaches full capacity.

Guest Admission Policy

1. Members must accompany guests at all times and are responsible for any damage they incur.
2. Admission fees as follows:
 - For associate member guest—\$5 fee at the gate.
 - For LLA member guest— \$2.50 fee at the gate.

Discount guest pass books— 10 passes, available at the LLA office.

 - Associate members- \$25.
 - LLA member- \$15.

Expire at end of pool season.
3. Limit of 10 guests at one time. Parties larger than 10 must notify the office prior to entering pool.
