

Coldstream Committee Minutes
4/1/08

Members Present: Kristin Smedley, Joe DuBoyce, Sandy Reed, Pat Veon and Lisa Martinis

The meeting was called to order at 7:35.

The first item discussed was the community yard sale/flea market.

It is scheduled for May 3 from 7:00 – 2:00.

The raindate is May 10.

Pat is our coordinator and contact for this event.

It has been submitted to the Lake Talk.

We are charging \$5 per spot.

Pat will have a list of who is responsible for each spot, and will ask people to clean and take away all their unsold things at the end of the day.

Sandi will have an ad put in the Frederick Post.

Joy has picket signs, and Pat will see if we can reuse them and change the information on them.

We will set up the spots in a horseshoe shape behind the parking lot in the open field.

Kristin will try to get a food vendor.

Sandy will get stakes from Home Depot to mark each spot and number them the night before.

Sandy will call Dawn and see if she wants to sell Baklava (or anything else)

Lisa will see if Girl Scouts want to unload the rest of their cookies or have a bake sale table.

We will sell cold drinks. Kristin will get from Cosco, we will all bring coolers on the day of the sale.

Pat will post flyers at the mailboxes in each village. Pat will also ask Joy to send out an email informing other neighbors in villages without group mailboxes.

We then discussed the Farmer's Market.

Sandy will see if we can write a letter to the board about getting it approved.

We would like to have it set up every other Tuesday, from 5:00-7:00.

Would like to have about 10-12 farmers.

Kristin has contacted a woman who has organized a Farmer's Market in the area and has gotten a lot of useful information from her. One thing is a list of vendors.

We will charge \$10 per space.

At our next meeting, we will talk about doing something to kick off the summer!

It was suggested that if our roads are not completed by Memorial Day Weekend, the Coldstream community needs to get together and have a "Park In". This means that the Coldstream residents

would take up all of the parking spots at the pool, at the lake and at the overflow parking lot. These spots would be occupied legally on a regular basis so that only those residents of Coldstream (who have suffered the most from this construction) would have access to our amenities.

It was also suggested to give the Board a gentle reminder to clean the beach and to add new sand before Memorial Day. Joe will call regarding this.
