

## Coldstream Committee 5/6/08 Meeting Minutes

Committee Members Present: Sandy Reed, Pat Veon, and Lisa Martinis  
Meeting was called to order at 7:35.

The first thing discussed was our yard sale. We had 16 people who paid \$5 each per space which equals \$84.00. So our profit was \$84 less advertising and supplies. We need to decide what we want to do with our Coldstream Money. We would like to do something to enhance the beach area. (Sandy will talk to Clay about expanding the beach with extra sand.) Pat learned some things with this yard sale to help for the next time we plan one. First, we need more detailed advertising. Also, we need bigger signs. And last, we need a longer prep time. Overall, it is felt that the yard sale was a success. Especially considering it is our first one.

It was brought up that we need to remind Coldstream residents to write letters for our Coldstream Good Neighbor Award. Bill has graciously offered to award a good neighbor each month with \$50. We need to advertise this in our next newsletter.

New Business – Sandy suggested that we add a boat race to our end of the summer beach party. She has also offered to organize this part of the event. We could charge an entry fee to help raise more money for Coldstream, or to use for this event. We would like to see if the band Proud Mary would be available and willing to be our entertainment again this year. We would have guests bring a dish again. We would like to do it sometime in late August. A possible date could be August 23<sup>rd</sup>. **(Joy, is there a pool party scheduled for August 23<sup>rd</sup>?)** As far as the boat race, it was suggested to have the race going along the length of the esplanade. Also, we would like to encourage people to decorate their boats like floats in a parade. We could call it, “Whatever Floats Your Boat”! (Pat and Sandy came up with this in unison!)

We discussed briefly the Parade On Wheels. Since the rest of our Committee is not present, we decided to have a separate meeting in the next week to discuss the details. It was suggested to have it on the Fourth of July, and make the parade a patriotic one also. This could also become a yearly event.

The committee received a letter from a resident regarding the overflow Coldstream Beach parking area. Apparently, that area is not being taken care of (mowed) on a regular basis by the Association. The neighbor feels that the Association requires residents to take care of their property regularly and the Association should be “held to those same standards”. Sandy will address this issue with Doug and/or Clay.

Ulla informed the Committee of some serious problems on Old Stonehouse Road. There are trails eroding from the storms, and other water related problems. Ulla went to the engineers of this project and the county supervisors and was able to get it taken care of. (Great job, Ulla!)
