

Coldstream Village Committee Meeting Minutes

9/4/07

Committee Members Present: Sandy, Pat and Lisa

The meeting was called to order at 7:45PM.

The committee was informed that the mailbox for Coldstream residents has been purchased. Sandy said that Clay will make sure it gets posted as soon as Joanne gets the box to him.

It was noted (quite happily) that the trash at Coldstream beach has been removed. This information will be included in the Coldstream letter as something the committee has accomplished thus far.

We discussed the get together for Coldstream residents at our beach. It was decided to change the date to Sept. 30, from 4 – 6. The concern was that there was not enough prep time to keep the old date of Sept. 16th. We will have snacks, music and we will ask people to bring something to share, and to bring whatever their family would like to drink. It was suggested that we post a reminder for the party a week prior on the board at the mailboxes. It was also decided that we will NOT provide games for kids, but instead suggest that people bring some things of their own. Dawn (a resident present) offered to get the party posted on the Coldstream sign at the road. And to also use that sign to announce Coldstream Committee Meetings.

Kristen came in and showed us all her draft of our newsletter. It was decided that for now, the newsletter will be mailed out instead of hand delivered. Sandy will get a mailing list from Joy (LLA) to print labels. Sandy will also request in writing to the Board to be able to get Jessica's (Security) report for Coldstream so that it can be included in future newsletters.

Sandy informed the Committee that a Fishing Tournament was suggested to her. It was suggested that Jay Decker would be the one for her to talk to, as he has done this in the past.

It was suggested to have a flier at the mailbox board with "pull off" pieces of paper with website information on each pull for residents to be able to access the website.

Sandi informed the Committee on what happened at the Board Meeting:

- A \$1.5 million line of credit was secured by the board for the CDA project. The water and sewer project is paid for in full by the county's utility enterprise fund, which means the cost is paid for by the end user.
- Contractors, along with the Association, are planning a meeting with Coldstream residents.
- It was reported that all the permits have been obtained.

A resident informed the Committee that there is a path between some houses that has been blocked for quite sometime. Sandi will try to find out when it will re-open. She will ask Clay.
