

Coldstream Committee Meeting Minutes October 7, 2008

The meeting began at 7 p.m.

Committee members present: Lisa Martinis, Pat Veon, Kristen Smedley.

The first thing discussed was the farmer's market for next year. We decided that the market will run from June 2, 2009 through September 29 on Tuesdays. Pat created a very nice application for us to give to potential participants. We decided to have more than one farmer next year, so as to not have to rely on the presence of only one. We also decided not to charge the participants for next year. We may look into selling some "green" bags to raise some money for the Coldstream Village. That will be discussed further at a later date.

We also discussed the concerns of many residents that the Coldstream roads be completed before the winter and snow season. It was noted that if it should snow before the roads are completed, that will pose a big problem for the plows and the pipes that are sitting very high from the road at this time. Lisa will let Joy know of this concern. It was also noted that LLA must have also thought of this and share this concern.

The Coldstream Fallfest was also discussed. We will meet there to set up at 1 p.m. A list of vendors was distributed and there will be at least 12 artist/crafters present. We only have one volunteer at this time to help with this event. So we decided not to set up the moonbounce. We will station our volunteer (thank you Sue) at the pumpkin painting. Lisa and Kristin will have a table and have agreed to sell coffee for Dublin Roasters. Pat will bring cream for the coffee, a table cloth for pumpkin decorating, and apple cider. Kristin will bring the paints. Lisa will bring cups for the cider and print and distribute flyers to advertise this event.

We also discussed the budget. Pat made a list of what the Coldstream Committee would like to request from the LLA board of directors. This includes additional mulch for the playground, additional sand for the beach and to extend the beach, a pavilion for the beach, additional tables at the beach and a boat dock for boats and fishing. Lisa will type a letter and send it to the board.

We then discussed the meeting that Lisa attended on Saturday at the request of the LLA Election Committee. The meeting focused on recruiting residents as candidates for the upcoming LLA board election. Lisa has agreed to help promote the planned workshops to the residents of Coldstream. Last, we decided that the committee would be happy to organize Thanksgiving dinner again this year for the firehouse. Lisa will organize this event on behalf of the committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 8 p.m.
