

Summerfield Village Committee
June 4, 2008 Meeting Minutes

Present: Jim Cates, June Cates, Alan McCracken, Judy Getz

Jim called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Because Jim has recently been elected to the LLA Board of Directors, he will no longer continue as the chairperson.

June Cates has agreed to be the chairperson.

A summary of the April, 2008 survey compiled by Alan McCracken was distributed.

10% of the community responded. This is considered a good response.

Average respondent has resided 9 years.

80% have children.

The Yard Sale and Pool Party were the most popular activities.

Most liked aspects of Summerfield: Neighbors (Community atmosphere), Pool, Close school.

Least liked aspects of Summerfield: Lack or inconsistent compliance enforcement; Entry way landscaping and sign; Pool area tables, chairs, landscaping (grass and trees), bathroom and pool deck maintenance and cleanliness.

Judy Getz noted that 7 people were willing to volunteer to help with Summerfield activities. She will distribute a list of names and contact information.

Jim noted that Clay Edwards (LLA General Manager) has already talked with the sub-contractor for the pool, and indicated dissatisfaction with last year's performance, and the need to improve this year. Pool lights would cost \$2500 each to replace.

There is a budget of \$1400 available for Summerfield.

The meeting adjourned at 7:05.
