Trash, Yard Waste, Recycling, and Bulk Item Collections in Lake Linganore

Trash Collection

The trash contractor, J&J Trash Services, supplies one (1) receptacle to each home free of charge. Any non-J&J Trash receptacles must be compatible with a side-arm collection truck. If a compatible non-J&J Trash receptacle is used, J&J will not be responsible for any damage to the can that occurs during or because of the collection. Bagged trash must be placed curbside in a covered, toter-style receptacle. Trash bags cannot weigh over 50 lbs. Trash outside of the toter will NOT be collected.

Residents are responsible for disposal of bulk items. Contact Frederick County Landfill (listed below) for information or visit their website for bulk item disposal information. The LLA currently offers one (1) Bulk Household Item collection in the spring (see below for additional details).

Trash collection is split into two separate days to serve Members best. Doing so allows the trash contractor to begin establishing routes to accommodate the growing community, decrease run-ins with school buses, reduce impeding traffic throughout villages, and collect trash timely. **New build homes can place trash out in either bagged trash or a receptacle for collection until a trash toter is delivered to the unit. Trash toter requests are sent over to the contractor once settlement statements are received. The trash contractor schedules and delivers trash toters weekly. Residents do not need to be home to accept the delivery.**

Yard Waste

Yard Waste Pickup: Weekly on Wednesday (April 5, 2023 – December 13, 2023)

Yard waste collection is weekly on Wednesday, from the first full week in April and through the second full week in December.

Yard waste can be placed at the curb in a bin clearly marked “Yard Waste” or in brown paper yard waste bags.

Grass, clippings, and leaves must be bagged (in paper bags) or placed in personal containers no larger than 30

gallons in size (clearly marked "Yard Waste"). Sticks and limbs must be bundled, and bundles may not be larger than 3 x 3 feet in size. Dirt, soil, and mulch are not accepted.

Accepted Items:

- Couches/Sofas/Love Seats/Futons
- Chairs/Stools/Recliners
- Tables
- Dressers
- Cabinets
- Shelves
- Nightstands
- Headboards
- Rugs/Carpet cut into 3'x3' squares and stacked/taped
- Water hoses
- Humidifiers (small plastic ones)
- Toys
- Car seats
- Toilets & Sinks
- Wood fencing cut into 3'x3' pieces and stacked/taped
- Bikes
- Exercise equipment
- TV's
- Scrap metal
- Lawnmowers (empty of gas/oil)
- Metal Pipes
- Grills

Items NOT Accepted:

- Mattresses & Box springs
- No Appliances**, including
- Refrigerators
 - Washers
 - Dryers
 - Stoves
 - A/C units
 - Microwaves
 - Hot water heaters

- No hazardous materials, including
- Medical waste
 - Chemical waste
 - Paint
 - Auto parts

Be sure to wrap any glass, and either remove nails entirely or be sure they are sticking in to prevent a potentially hazardous situation.

Please consider donating any gently used items to a charity of your choice. All bulk items collected during Bulk Item Pickup will be brought to the landfill.
